

MINOR IN AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL DEMOCRACY

General Requirements

A minimum of fifteen (15) credits are required for the minor. Students in the minor must maintain a B average (3.0 GPA) for courses in the minor.

A minimum of twelve (12) credits must come from the list of approved courses found at <http://democracy.missouri.edu/programs/undergraduate/minor/>. At least nine (9) hours must be completed at MU. Additionally, a minimum of three (3) credits must come from an experiential component. The experiential component may be satisfied through participation in either an internship or study abroad program associated with the minor or approved by the director of the minor.

*Note: Students may *not* use a course to fulfill both a major and a minor requirement. Per university regulations students may take a maximum of 42 hours in their major course of study, and the minor must therefore include at least one course outside of the student's major field. For example, a student majoring in one discipline may not complete the minor by taking 15 additional credit hours in the same discipline.
