## MINOR IN AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL DEMOCRACY

## **General Requirements**

A minimum of fifteen (15) credits are required for the minor with a minimum of twelve (12) credits coming from the list of approved courses found at https://democracy.missouri.edu/programs/undergraduate-programs/minor-certificate. At least nine (9) hours must be completed at MU, and three (3) credits must come from an experiential component associated with the minor or approved by the director of the minor. The following conditions also apply to students pursuing the Minor in American Constitutional Democracy:

- All coursework for the minor must be completed with a grade of C- or higher, and students must have an aggregate GPA of 3.0 in all courses used for the minor;
- A maximum of three (3) hours of experiential credit can be applied toward the minor;
- A minimum of six (6) hours of minor coursework must be at the 4000-level or higher;
- The minor must be completed and awarded at the same time as the MU undergraduate degree;
- The same coursework cannot be used for multiple A&S minors

\*Note: Students may *not* use a course to fulfill both a major and a minor requirement. Since students may take a maximum of 42 hours in their major course of study, coursework for the minor must include at least one class outside of the student's major. Minor coursework also cannot be used to fulfill a Foreign Language Alternative.
