

CERTIFICATE IN AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL DEMOCRACY

General Requirements

A minimum of twelve (12) credits are required for the Certificate and must come from the list of approved courses found at <https://democracy.missouri.edu/programs/undergraduate-programs/minor-certificate>. In addition, the following conditions apply to all students pursuing the Certificate in American Constitutional Democracy:

- All coursework for the certificate must be completed with a grade of C- or higher, and students must have an aggregate GPA of 3.0 in all courses used for the certificate;
- A maximum of 3 hours of experiential credit can be applied toward the certificate;
- A minimum of 6 hours of certificate coursework must be at the 4000-level or higher;
- The certificate must be completed and awarded at the same time as the MU undergraduate degree

*Note: courses used to satisfy a major requirement may also count toward a certificate. However, students may not receive credit for *both* the certificate and the minor in American Constitutional Democracy.
