OVER THE PAST FOUR YEARS, THE SHAWNEE TRAIL REGIONAL SEMINAR HAS PROVIDED A SERIOUS BUT CONVIVIAL SETTING FOR SCHOLARS WORKING ON ANY TOPIC RELATED TO AMERICAN POLITICS OR CONSTITUTIONALISM TO EXCHANGE IDEAS WITH COLLEAGUES. THE FIFTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE AIMS TO FOSTER INTELLECTUAL CONNECTIONS BETWEEN INSTITUTIONS IN THIS REGION AND BEYOND. SCHOLARS INTERESTED IN AMERICAN CONSTITUTIONAL AND POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT AND/OR AMERICAN POLITICAL THOUGHT ARE PARTICULARLY ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE. MEETINGS TAKE PLACE ANNUALLY, ROTATING BETWEEN COLUMBIA, MO AND OTHER LOCATIONS. A ROUNDTABLE FORMAT IS UTILIZED, WITH PRESENTERS CIRCULATING PAPERS IN ADVANCE OF THE MEETING.
