### 3.5- and 4-Year Options for Degree Completion

The JD/MA in Atlantic History & Politics Dual Degree program provides a variety of flexible options for students to complete the Dual Degree program in 3.5 or 4 years.

#### For students pursuing the 3.5-year program, option 1:

- -apply to the MA before the 1st year of law school
- -study in Oxford the summer before your first year of law school
- -complete additional program requirements as outlined on the degree sheet throughout your 2L and 3L years, plus an additional Fall semester.

#### For students pursuing the 3.5-year program, option 2:

- -apply to the MA during the 1st year of law school
- -study in Oxford the summer following your first year of law school
- -complete additional program requirements as outlined on the degree sheet throughout your 2L and 3L years, plus an additional Fall semester.

#### For students pursuing the 3.5-year program, option 3:

- -apply to the MA during the 2nd year of law school
- -study in Oxford the summer following your second year of law school
- -complete additional program requirements as outlined on the degree sheet throughout your 2L and 3L years, plus an additional Fall semester.
- -Note: This option assumes the student will have taken credit hours during the summer following their 1L year or during 1L or 2L intersessions. To see if you qualify for this option, contact the JD/MA Program Advisor Caroline Spalding (mcskf5@mail.missouri.edu).

## For students pursuing the 4-year program:

- -apply to the MA during the 1st or 2nd year of law school
- -study in Oxford the summer following your first or second year of law school
- -complete additional program requirements as outlined on the degree sheet throughout your 2L and 3L years, plus an additional year.
